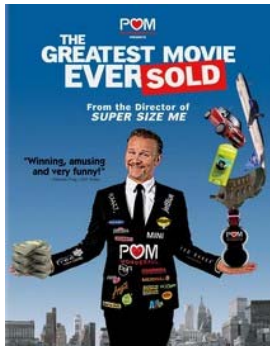

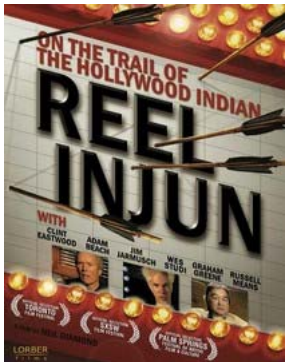


February 3—The Greatest Movie Ever Sold (2011, 90 minutes)

Intrepid filmmaker Morgan Spurlock (Super Size Me) directs this biting ironic documentary, which scrutinizes the pervasive marketing, advertising and product placement practices that have become de rigeur in the entertainment industry.

February 10—Exporting Raymond (2010, 85 minutes)

"Everybody Loves Raymond" creator Philip Rosenthal writes, directs and stars in this fish-out-of-water documentary that chronicles his attempts to adapt his hit sitcom for Russian television.



February 17—Reel Injun (2009, 88 minutes)

This engrossing documentary reveals the film industry's effect on the experiences of North American native people in the United States and Canada, who've been depicted in movies in a variety of ways -- many of them wildly inaccurate.

February 24—The Last Mountain (2011, 95 minutes)

This gripping documentary follows ordinary citizens in West Virginia's Coal River Valley as they wage a campaign to prevent the infamous Massey Energy Company from expanding ruinous mountaintop removal mining operations in their community.
